## **FSSC 24000 JOURNEY**

## **Obtained recognition and benchmarking**

#### ➤ SSCI (January 2024)

Foundation FSSC has successfully completed the SSCI Benchmarking process and achieved SSCI Recognition for FSSC 24000.

#### > IAF MLA (April 2024)

The International Accreditation Forum (IAF) and Foundation FSSC signed an updated Scheme Endorsement Agreement to recognize the FSSC 24000 certification Scheme under the IAF Multilateral Recognition Arrangement (MLA).

#### **▶** International Trade Center Standards Map (May 2024)

Alongside the FSSC 22000 Scheme, we completed the process of benchmarking the FSSC 24000 Scheme and having it listed on the Standards Map database.

## **Stage 1 Office Assessment**

- All CBs holding an FSSC 24000 (provisional) license have successfully completed the Stage 1 Remote Assessment.
- Positive development of the Stage 1 Office Assessment Findings.


#### **Desk Reviews**

## **FSSC 24000 TECHNICAL BENEFITS**

#### **Integration and Transition**

FSSC 24000 enables seamless integration and transition of existing and valid certificates held by organizations that have an existing accredited third-party social certification to another standard or certification program recognized by SSCI.

#### Key benefits are:

- ➤ The audit duration of the transition audit can be reduced based on the existing certification.
- ➤ A transition that covers all aspects of human rights obligations and supply chain due diligence.



## **FSSC 24000 TECHNICAL SUPPORT**

A set of guidance documents is available to support the implementation of FSSC 24000:

# **FSSC 24000 TECHNICAL SUPPORT**

## MyFSSC

The Foundation FSSC provides Scheme interpretation articles for Certification Bodies holding a (provisional) license and for Accreditation Bodies.

## **FSSC 24000 CB APPLICATION PROCESS**

#### Pre-approval process:

- Submit the application package (ip@fssc.com)
  - Completed application form & Copy of existing accreditation to ISO 17021-1
- 2. Contractual documentation 1 month
  - Signed license agreement & Data Protection Agreement (DPA)
  - Implementation plan (resource analysis/business plan)
- 3. Payment of the initial one-time CB entry fee
- 4. AB acceptance; Counter-sign license and DPA  $\rightarrow$  Provisional license



## **FSSC 24000 CB APPLICATION PROCESS**

- Provisional status: 1-3 months
- 1. Mandatory training course (E-learning) Scheme managers and auditors
- 2. Auditor qualification & accreditation plan (Auditors: APSCA approved)

#### **Mentoring Session**

- 3. Desk Review & Office assessment (remote) CB procedures
- 4. Can conduct unaccredited audits
  - 12 months to gain accreditation to FSSC 24000 from the provisional license date
- Full license
